

ITALIAN COURSES TUITION

The standard course meets for a scheduled one-and-a-half-hour session once a week for 12 weeks (Fall) and 18 weeks (Winter and Spring) for a total of 30 lessons. Courses have a minimum of 3 students.

ITALIAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM

The objective of our courses is to develop comprehension and speaking skills. To reach this goal, we organize the kids into small groups and give the personal attention the child needs, according to age and level. Children will speak, read and write using traditional methods, but also will learn vocabulary and grammar by playing and moving, using the Total Physical Response approach. They will learn about Italian culture and traditions by creating artwork, singing songs, watching videos, and engaging in other age-appropriate activities. Children and teens are properly stimulated in order to develop a positive attitude toward learning the Italian language. At the end of the year, students will receive a Certificate of attendance. Our Italian teachers receive periodical training. The syllabi include preparation for the AP exam in Italian. We also offer preparation for the Italian SAT subject test.

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ICS MUSIC SCHOOL

FIRST APPROACH TO MUSIC & VIOLIN

4-7 yrs. old – TBD

The course will be taught through real musical experiences where the children will be completely immersed in music. We will start by knowing the music that accompanies us every day, the music of our body, of our heart. We will listen to symphonic pieces and transform them into emotions through movement and drawing. And finally, we will enter the world of the violin from its origins to its technique. This will allow a gradual and spontaneous acquisition of basic theoretical-musical knowledge.

CHORUS in Italiano

The project will focus on a weekly meeting and will present a mixed repertoire. The range of music will be gradual and diversified by genre, origin, and difficulty that will take into account the vocal range and the characteristics of the components of the various sections of the choir.
